OVERNIGHT CAMPING / EARLY QUEUEING

For the wellbeing and safety of our patrons, camping for the Harry Styles Love on Tour Concert on Monday 20 February is strictly prohibited at HBF Park. We will be working closely with the relevant stakeholders and will have security dedicated to policing this. Queueing will be permitted on show day from 8am at the gate noted on your ticket. Any patrons queueing or camping prior to this will be asked to move on and refused entry as per our Conditions of Entry. Please note that fan made early line systems will **not** be honored. Any bags left unattended will be disposed of.

If you are intending on arriving early, we recommend looking at the weather forecast and bringing appropriate items with you such as sunscreen, a hat and water. The queueing area is located outside of the venue and not all areas are covered by shade.

AGE REQUIREMENTS

Children under the age of 16 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian at all times and both must have a valid event ticket.

BAG POLICY

Bags are permitted if A4 size or smaller (30cm x 20cm) No backpacks or large bags permitted.

ARTIST GIFTS

No gifts will be accepted on behalf of the artist or promoter. Gifts are not permitted inside the venue and must be discarded at entry gates. Unwrapped items can be cloaked.

CLOAKING

Free cloaking facilities are available onsite external to each gate entry. Small personal items only, strictly no wrapped gifts, large items or equipment.

FLAGS, BANNERS & POSTERS

Flags must be no larger than 1m x 1m, poles are not permitted Banners must be no larger than A1 (59.4cm x 84.1cm) in size, poles are not permitted

Flags, banners or posters must not contain any offensive language or political messaging

PASS OUTS

This is a no pass out event

STROBE LIGHTING

Please be aware strobe lighting will be used throughout the performance. There will be haze used at points during and at the end of the performance.

CAMERA POLICY

Cameras (including digital cameras), audio and video recorders may only be brought into the Stadium at the discretion of Stadium Management (VenuesWest). In general, cameras with a detachable lens or lens larger than 200mm are not permitted

Video cameras, professional camera equipment/ lenses or audio recording devices (basic point and shoot disposable cameras) are permitted
